Greetings:

This letter is to inform you that the railroad on which you are now employed is a party to the September 23, 1986 Agreement, which among other provisions contains Article V, Seniority Retention. Local Lodge No. _____ has jurisdiction over the territory on which you hold seniority.

Since you have been promoted to an official, supervisory, or excepted position from the craft or class represented by the Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen, you may elect to retain and accumulate seniority within the craft or class represented by the Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen so long as you pay a quarterly fee (currently \$_____ to Local Lodge No. _____. The fee must be paid in advance and received on or before the last day of the first month of each calendar quarter the same as members pay dues. In the event you fail to pay such fees, the duly authorized representative of the Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen shall so notify the designated carrier officer with a copy to you.

At your request, a hearing for reinstatement similar to that provided a current employee represented by the Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen shall be provided.

Failure to pay the Seniority Retention fee shall result in the termination of your seniority, and your name shall be removed from the appropriate seniority rosters.
